Program: Flooding issues and City response with Bernie Lenz, City Utilities Manager	Bernie presented the City's model for dealing with storm water and answered questions. In the city there are 5 watershed or collection areas through which water is channeled via pipes. Improving flow is a multi-year process as areas are improved when street work is done. Residents may earn credit on their water bills by participating in a green infrastructure program (rain barrels and rain gardens). We are getting about the same amount of rain, but it is coming over shorter time periods (ie, rain events are more intense).
