Welcome to the Weigent-Hogan Neighborhood! We're bordered by Jackson Street/State Road on the south, Losey Boulevard on the east, Cass Street on the north and West Ave on the west.

The Weigent-Hogan Neighborhood association (WHNA) is a City of La Crosse recognized neighborhood association. Working with the City Planning Department and the Neighborhood Revitalization Commission, WHNA works to strengthen our residential area and to promote neighborhood businesses.

Membership in WHNA is free for any resident, property owner, representative from a religious or educational institution, business or non-profit in our neighborhood. WHNA works with all members to sustain a healthy, safe, well-maintained neighborhood, and a vibrant sense of community. If eligible, one may become a member simply by attending one general membership meeting per year and signing the roster.

WHNA is a resource for finding help in your community, connecting with community resources, sharing information and meeting neighbors.

If you are interested in learning more about WHNA, the best way is by attending a general member meeting. They are held the second Monday of the month from 6:30-8:00 PM at the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship Hall, 401 West Avenue S.

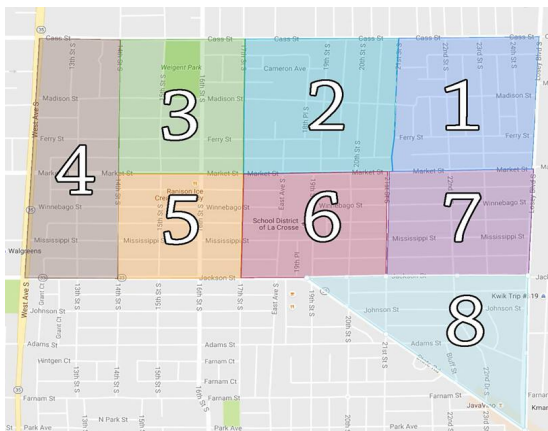
Membership:

Any resident, property owner, representative from a religious or educational institution, business or non-profit in this neighborhood is eligible for membership. If eligible, one may become a voting member by attending one general member meeting a calendar year and signing the roster.

Boundaries:

The boundaries of the association are:

- West Avenue between Jackson Street and Cass Street
- Cass Street between West Avenue and Losey Boulevard
- Losey Boulevard between Cass Street and State Road 33
- State Road 33 between Losey Blvd and Jackson Street
- Jackson Street between State Road 33 and West Avenue.



To assist with communication, WHNA has broken the neighborhood into eight districts. Each district has a designated

WHNA ambassador.

Meetings:

WHNA meetings are held the second Monday of the month from 6:30 pm to 8 pm at the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship Building, 401 West Ave.

Committees:

The **Membership Committee** focuses on creating opportunities for social interaction among those defined as eligible for membership in the WHNA.

The **Environment Committee** focuses on the ecological health of our neighborhood and will seek out, develop and educate our neighborhood regarding green projects (e.g., maintaining the tree canopy, edible landscaping, wheel chair gardening and planting for pollinators)

The **Infrastructure Committee** works to ensure the neighborhood infrastructure such as parks, homes, businesses and streets are safe and well maintained.

- Promoting boulevard tree replacement
- Advocating for the city transportation vision
- Promoting the reduction of condemned and vacant housing
