There really hasn't been the opportunity to recruit Committee volunteers. We are rethinking the concept of standing committees and are considering going to project based committees instead. Volunteers would then have a more limited commitment which may spur more interest in serving.</p> <p>Currently the Environment, Infrastructure and Membership committees operate with 2-4 members on each committee.</p>
