Introduction and presentation	Greg Clark, Matt Gallagher, Tim Acklin	<p>Matt Gallagher enumerated the city's street projects for the summer and beyond. He told us of the difference of philosophy between the city's desire for safer and more multiuse streets and the state's objective of keeping cars moving! In WHNA, Ferry around 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> will be getting porous pavement rather than new storm sewer. He addressed many specific questions about WHNA and some general questions about streets in downtown LaCrosse.</p> <p>Tim Acklin talked about the NRC proposal to change the parking ordinance that will affect # of off-street parking spots. He had met with the other NA and will add our comments in order to revise and incorporate feedback rather than let the proposal die. Concerns were for changes after Covid, street cleaning and plowing, daytime/nighttime differences. Downtown, GENA, and Washburn are particularly affected by on street parking. He will return in June after revisions are made.</p>
